

Course Management System (CMS) Needs Assessment and Evaluation

Update as of September 2010: SDCCD IT has completed negotiations with Blackboard for a hosted service for Blackboard Learn 9.1. An implementation team to work out the technical setup has been formed, comprised of representatives from the Districtwide Distance Education Steering Committee, SDCCD IT, and SDCCD Online Learning Pathways will convene in October to start planning of the Blackboard Learn implementation.

Update as of June 2010: The results of the faculty evaluation of the CMS options, which included the feedback from faculty who participated in the review process and the four Friday Faculty Forums conducted in May and June, have been reviewed by SDCCD Online Learning Pathways and the Districtwide Distance Education Steering Committee; and the consensus is to continue with Blackboard and upgrade to the new version, Blackboard Learn 9.1

History of Course Management System Review and Evaluation conducted Fall 2009 through Spring 2010.

Background: Our Blackboard Vista 8 system will be supported by Blackboard until Fall 2012. If we stay with Blackboard, we will need to migrate to Blackboard Learn 9.1 or 9.2, or whatever 9+ version they are on when we are ready. The migration will involve some re-training and movement of courses to the new platform.

Question: Should we stay on the Blackboard path or find another system to deliver our online and web-enhanced courses? To answer this question, I invite the online faculty to participate in a strategic review and planning effort to reach consensus about the future direction for SDCCD's course management system. (For a list of the CMS's currently used by other CCC's, see the attached spreadsheet.)

First Step: We need to get as much input as possible from the online faculty about what tools are most important in a course management system. The Online Faculty Needs Assessment is a quick way for you to indicate your must-have and wish list of tools and features of a course management system. Survey link:
